The petitioner is seeking a direction to the respondents to allow him to continue on the post of Computer Operator. He has also sought a direction to the respondents to release his salary from September, 2019.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner had been appointed as a Computer Operator on the basis of outsourcing policy. He had been working as a Computer Operator and had been doing work relating to recording of births and deaths through DITS in the Municipal Council. The petitioner had been working till September, 2019 and he had not been allowed to join the work thereafter.

Heard.

It is manifest that the petitioner had been appointed as a Computer Operator on the basis of outsourcing policy of the State of Haryana. I have perused the material on record. There is no appointment letter appointing the petitioner to work as a Computer Operator.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has referred to the documents, including Annexure P9, showing that the petitioner along with others was working as a Computer Operator in the Municipal Council. Nonetheless the petitioner having been appointed through outsourcing agency, he would not be entitled to the relief claimed in this petition, especially when there is no appointment letter in view of the law laid down by a Division Bench of this Court in the case of Nishan Singh and others v. State of Punjab and others, 2014 (11) RCR (Civil) 262.

Consequently, the petition stands dismissed.

Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
