Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No. 131 dated 01.05.2020, registered under Sections 452, 324, 323, 148, 149 IPC, (Section 326 IPC added later on vide Rapat No. 29 dated 01.05.2021), at Police Station Sadar Fazilka, District Fazilka.

Vide order dated 19.01.2022 passed by this Court, *ad interim* anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the aforesaid order dated 19.01.2022, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Balkarran Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for any further investigation.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 19.01.2022 granting *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
