Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as the petitioner has got registered an FIR No.101 dated 28.11.2021 under Sections 452, 323, 324, 427, 148 and 149 of the IPC against the private respondents, now his life and liberty is under threat at the hands of private respondents as the private respondents are giving threats to his life and liberty in case the petitioner does not compromise the said dispute with them.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the said fact has already been brought to the notice of the respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, District Tarn Taran by way of filing a representation dated 30.12.2021 (Annexure P/4), which is still pending

consideration with the said respondent and the petitioner will be satisfied, at

this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sandeep Singh Deol, DAG, Punjab, who has joined the proceedings through video conference, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and states that the representation dated 30.12.2021 (Annexure P/4), submitted by the petitioner will be decided within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order. In case, after the decision, it is found that any action needs to be taken, the same will also be taken without any further delay.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in representation dated 30.12.2021 (Annexure P/4), respondent No.2 is directed to decide the representation dated 30.12.2021 (Annexure P/4), submitted by the petitioner by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
