Affidavit on behalf of respondent No.3 has been filed in the
Court today and the same is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the question of
law raised in the present petition is covered by the judgment of the Division
Bench of this Court in *LPA No.982 of 2017 titled as Yudhvir vs. Reena
and others, pronounced on 20.10.2022*, hence, the present petition be also
disposed in the same terms and conditions.

Learned counsel for respondent No.3-Commission does not
dispute the said fact.

Keeping in view the above, the present petition is also disposed of in same terms as in *Yudhvir's case (supra)*.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner be given liberty to approach the respondents to claim the consequential benefits of the said appointment from the date person junior to him, in the merit has been granted appointment.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State submits that in case any such claim is raised by the petitioner, the same will be considered in accordance with law and appropriate order on the same will be passed within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of any such claim.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further qua the said prayer, with liberty as prayed for.

Ordered accordingly.

As the main case is disposed of, applications i.e. CM-9951-CWP-2022 and CM-2728-CWP-2020 also stand disposed of.
