This invocation under Section 24 of the Code of Civil
Procedure filed by the wife seeks transfer of petition under
Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act 1955 titled as **Manender
Thakkar** Vs. **Kavita**” pending between the parties to this
application in the Court of learned Principal Judge, Family
Court, Panipat to the Court of competent jurisdiction at District

Courts, Faridabad, which was preferred by the husband seeking dissolution of the marriage with the wife, the present applicant.

Shri Sandeep Verma, Advocate for the respondent filed of attorney and has made statement that he does not intend to file reply to the application.

Upon hearing counsel for the parties and perusal of the records.

The relative distance between Faridabad and Panipat is approximately 125 kilometers. The wife admittedly is presently living with her aged parents. It is on account of the amorous relationship alleged by the wife, which has led to the break up of this matrimony and thus compelling the wife to re-assert her rights by way of complaint under the Domestic Violence Act besides getting registered a matrimonial case by way of FIR 108 dated 15.07.2019 with Women Police Station District Faridabad against the husband. From this, it is quite suggestive that acrimony stems from the conduct of the husband and the reasonable threat to life of the applicant as

canvassed by her counsel are certainly there and which is itself an exceptional ground to accede to the prayer of the wife.

In the light of the same, the instant application stands allowed. The petition titled as titled as **Manender Thakkar** Vs. **Kavita**” pending in the Family Court, Panipat is hereby ordered to be transferred to the Family Court at Faridabad.
