The prayer in the petition under Section 482 Cr.PC is for quashing of General Diary No.24 dated 09.04.2020 under Sections 451, 506, 188 IPC registered at Police Station Model Town, Hoshairpur on the basis of compromise deed dated 09.05.2020 (Annexure P-2).

Vide order dated 10.03.2021 the parties were directed to appear before the Trial Court for recording their statements with respect to the compromise. However, the complainant did not turn up. Thereafter vide order dated 24.08.2022 another opportunity was afforded to the parties to get their statements recorded in terms of the compromise. However, as per report dated 22.09.2022 the parties have once again not appeared for getting their statements recorded with regard to the compromise before the Trial Court.

In view of the above, the present petition is hereby dismissed.
