[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating action against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order (Annexure P-1) dated 06.05.2019 in CWP No.11762 of 2019.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1) reveals that CWP No.11762 of 2019 was disposed of vide order dated 06.05.2019 by directing the respondents to pass appropriate speaking order on the claim raised by the petitioner in legal notice dated 08.01.2019 within 03 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] Notice has yet not been issued in the instant case.

[4] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that speaking order (Annexure R-1/1T) dated 07.10.2019 has been passed, deciding legal notice dated 08.01.2019 and benefits as per entitlement determined therein have also been released to the petitioner, therefore the
