The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 733 dated 20.11.2021, registered under Sections 332, 341, 353, 506 IPC at Police Station City Narnaul, District Mahendergarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a per allegations in the FIR, registered at the instance of complainant Pardeep Kumar, Assistant Secretary, RTA Office, Narnaul, it is stated that he along with co-officials had impounded two vehicles bearing registration numbers HR-66-B-9503 and HR-66-B-7432, which were found overloaded and in the meantime, a Bolero vehicle bearing registration number HR-35-K-9009 came from the opposite side, in which two persons were present. They got stopped the vehicles and manhandled with the complainant party, who were on official duty. In the meantime, the driver of the vehicle number HR-66-B-9503 succeeded in running away and both the persons tried to rescue the overloaded vehicles and in that process, the complainant also

gave a call at 112 for police help and then a camper driver also ran away.

Learned counsel further submits that in fact it is a case where the petitioner, being owner of the vehicles, was called by the complainant and has falsely been implicated in this case.

Learned State counsel has opposed the prayer of the petitioner on the ground that the petitioner, being owner of the vehicles, tried to forcibly get the same released from the custody of RTA Staff and in that process, they succeeded in helping the drivers to run away.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, considering the serious allegation against the petitioner, I do not find any ground to grant him the concession of anticipatory bail.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
