Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to give one more opportunity to the petitioner for verification of the documents for appointment to the post of Ward Attendant.

At the outset, learned Counsel on instructions from the petitioner submits that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case the representation dated 26.12.2021 (P-6) is considered and decided expeditiously.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Maloo Chahal, DAG, Punjab, who is present through Video-Conference, accepts notice on behalf of the

respondent(s) and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer of the petitioner.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without expressing any opinion about the claim of the petitioner, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to the respondent(s) to consider and decide the aforesaid representation dated 26.12.2021 (P-6) in accordance with law by passing speaking order within two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
