This petition in the nature of Habeas Corpus was filed seeking custody of the detenue-Aarveer Singh i.e. minor son of the petitioner.

From the pleadings, it is forthcoming that there is dispute between the petitioner and grandparents of the child.

Learned counsel for respondent No. 4 submits that petitioner has filed a petition under Section 6 of the Hindu Minority and Guardianship Act, 1956 read with Section 7 and 10 of the Guardian and Wards Act, 1890 and now the next date is fixed for 22nd December, 2022.

In view of the fact that petitioner has availed remedy provided under the Statute, no interference is called for.

Petition is disposed of.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would move an application for interim relief and prays that the same be decided in a time bound manner.

There is no doubt that in eventuality of petitioner moving an application for interim relief, the same would be decided by the Court concerned expeditiously in accordance with law.
