ANIL KSHETARPAL, J (Oral)

The petitioner herein, is a wholly owned State Government organization. Its prayer before the Executing Court for releasing its property from attachment has been dismissed. Admittedly, the Regular Second Appeal against the judgment and decree is pending, in which execution of the decree has been ordered to be stayed. Continuation of attachment of the Bank account of the petitioner organization is hampering its working. This organization is in the business of procurement of foodgrains for the State as well as the Central Government. Once the execution of the decree has been stayed, no useful purpose shall be served in keeping the Bank account of the petitioner organization under attachment. Hence, the order dated 30.09.2020 is set aside.

Needless to observe that after the decision of the Regular Second Appeal, the decree-holder shall be at liberty to proceed with the matter.

With these observations, the revision petition is allowed.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
