[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating action against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 22.12.2017 in CWP No.12327 of 2017.

[2] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the matter has been amicably resolved between the parties for ensuring compliance with order, Annexure P/1 dated 22.12.2017 in CWP No.12327 of 2017, therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioner does not press the contempt petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.
