The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.271 dated 11.12.2021, registered under Section 21 (b) of NDPS Act, 1985 (Section 29 of NDPS Act, 1985 added later on) at Police Station City Kotkapura, District Faridkot.

Vide order dated 10.01.2022 passed by this Court, the petitioner was granted interim bail and the operative part of the said order is reproduced hereunder:-

“Notice of motion for 22.03.2022.

Mr. Tanvir Joshi, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. Copy of the paper book be supplied to learned State counsel, during the course of the day by hand or through e-mail.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to join the investigation. In the event of arrest, petitioner shall be released on pre-arrest bail at the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer subject to the following conditions, as envisaged under section 438(2) Cr.P.C:-

- (i) *that the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;*
- (ii) *that the petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;*
- (iii) *that the petitioner shall not leave India without the previous permission of the Court.”*

Upon instructions from SI Gurmail Kaur, learned State counsel submits that in compliance of the aforesaid orders, the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, order dated 10.01.2022 passed by this Court is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Accordingly, the petition stands disposed of.
