1. Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order Annexure P/1 dated 20.09.2019, in CWP-26935-2019.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP-26935-2019 was disposed of by directing the respondent to take action on representation dated 10.07.2019 by considering the report of the Patwari with the necessary exercise to be done within six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

3. Mr. Ayush Sarna, AAG, Punjab has filed reply by way of short affidavit of Sh. Devinder Singh, Chief Engineer, Drainage-cum-Mines & Geology-1, Water Resources Department, Punjab, Chandigarh along with copy of speaking order, Annexure R/1 besides, revised speaking order Annexure R/4 dated 19.04.2022/31.10.2022. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in view of the claim of the

rejected by the competent authority, the petitioner does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to challenge speaking order Annexure R/1 and revised speaking order Annexure R-4 dated 19.04.2022/31.10.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

4. The same is not opposed to by the learned State counsel.

5. In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
