Prayer in this petition, filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus to release the detinue, namely Jasveer Kaur, who is stated to be legally wedded wife of petitioner Shaminder Singh.

As per petition, the detinue is now in the custody of private respondents, who are her family members.

Learned State counsel has placed on record the statement of Jasveer Kaur in vernacular form, recorded by ASI Amritpal Singh, wherein she has stated that she has gone to the house of her real brother of her own and will return after taking treatment.

Considering the fact that the alleged detinue is stated to be 22 years of age and is residing at the house of her real brother, it cannot be termed that she is in illegal detention, in view of her statement made before the said police official.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed as infructuous.
