[1] This order shall decide COCP No.1859 of 2015, COCP No.536 of 2019 and COCP No.94 of 2019, as claim in all the three petitions is with regard to intentional and willful defiance of order (Annexure P-7) dated 16.10.2014 in COCP No.3059 of 2012 in case titled as '**Vijay Kumar and others**versus**R.S. Ballian and another**'.

[2] At the outset, learned counsel for the respondent on

instructions of the MD, PRTC, states that interest would be paid to the petitioner(s) on the enhanced amount of gratuity as has already been released within two month from today.

[3] The same satisfies learned counsel for petitioner(s), who states that in the circumstances, he does not press the instant petition(s).

[4] Accordingly, in view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the parties, the instant petition(s) are *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while directing the respondent to adhere to the assurance made through the learned counsel for the respondent and to release interest on the delayed payment of enhanced gratuity within two months from today. Needless to mention, in case, payment on account of interest is not released to the petitioner(s), the petitioner(s) would be at liberty to move an application for revival of the instant petition(s).
