Respondent No.6 is stated to have died.

Counsel for respondents No.4 and 5 submitted that actually civil litigation is going on between the children of the petitioner and respondents No.4 to 6. He further submitted that the private respondents never threatened to cause any harm to the petitioners. Even in the written reply filed on behalf of the State, it is stated that in the inquiry, it was found that no such threat was ever given by the private respondents to the petitioner.

Even today counsel for the petitioner submitted that respondents No.4 and 5 are regularly giving threats to the petitioner to cause harm as they wanted to usurp the property owned by father-in-law of the petitioner.

In view of above, the present petition is hereby disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to look into the matter and to assess the threat perception, if any, is there to the petitioner from the hands of respondents No.4 and 5 and to provide her necessary protection, if circumstances so warrant.
