Due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19, the instant case is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

The petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking prayer by way of writ of *certiorari* for quashing the impugned orders dated 22.09.2021 (Annexure P-5) vide which the pension of the petitioner is reduced to 50% provisional pension and order dated 04.10.2019 (Annexure P-4) vide which pension was reduced

to 75% provisional and also for the quashing of order dated 30.05.2003 (Annexure P-2) vide which death cum retirement gratuity of the petitioner was withheld by the respondents and released him only provisional pension.

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with the directions to the official respondents to consider the representations dated 18.05.2020, 01.10.2021, 06.10.2021, 28.09.2021, 11.11.2021 & 25.09.2021 (Annexures P-9 to P-13, respectively) moved by the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the relief, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
