GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J.

1. The petitioners have approached this Court seeking quashing of G.D. No.039 dated 19.10.2019 in FIR No.126 dated 19.10.2019, Police Station Machhiwara, District Khanna, under Sections 323, 324 and 34 of Indian Penal Code and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise effected between the parties.
2. This Court vide order dated 3.3.2020 had directed the petitioners to deposit an amount of Rs. 10,000/- each and to produce receipts. The receipt in original has been produced today indicating deposit of the amount and the same is taken on record.
3. Vide order dated 9.1.2020, the parties had been directed to appear before the Trial Court/Illaq Magistrate so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.

4. Report of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Samrala has been received, wherein it has been reported that the statements of petitioners/accused Amarjit Singh, Baljinder Kaur and also of respondent Nos.2 and 3 namely Inderjit Kaur and Amandeep Kaur have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves.
5. Respondents Nos.2 and 3 namely Inderjit Kaur and Amandeep Kaur in their statements have stated that they have no objection in case the FIR in question is quashed.
6. Learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Samrala has specifically opined that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily without there being any pressure, coercion or undue influence.
7. In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and G.D. No.039 dated 19.10.2019 in FIR No.126 dated 19.10.2019, Police Station Machhiwara, District Khanna, under Sections 323, 324 and 34 of Indian Penal Code and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed qua petitioners.
