[1] Prayer in the instant petition under Articles 226 / 227 of the Constitution of India is for the issuance of a writ of mandamus for considering the petitioner eligible for appointment to the post of Constable (Male), Commando Wing, Haryana Police and to recommend him for selection in view of his merit ranking.

[2] Notice has yet not been issued in the instant case. Learned State Counsel who had taken time to refer to the record as also to obtain instructions and to assist in the matter, although, has not filed any response, yet states that on re-appraisal of the grievance of the petitioner, the claim of the petitioner for appointment to the post of Constable (Male), Commando Wing, Haryana Police has been accepted, accordingly name of the petitioner has been recommended by respondent No.3 to respondent No. 2 for appointment as Constable (Male), Commando Wing, Haryana Police.

[3] Mr. Tapan Kumar, learned DAG states that in the circumstances, the instant petition has become infructuous and may be disposed of, as such.

statement of the learned DAG, he does not press the instant petition and the same may be disposed of as having become infructuous, while directing respondent No.2 to take follow-up action in terms of the recommendation made by respondent No.3 in a time bound manner.

[5] In the light of the position noted above, the writ petition is *disposed of* as having become infructuous while directing respondent No.2 to take follow-up action on the recommendation, as made by respondent No.3, qua the petitioner for appointment to the post of Constable (Male), Commando Wing, Haryana Police in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible.

[6] Writ petition *disposed of* with the aforementioned directions.
