B.S. Walia, J. (Oral)

1. Mr. Vipul Ujwal, Chief Administrator, GMADA, is present in person, in compliance of order dated 29.01.2020 and states that record directed to be provided to the Collector Agrarian, Kapurthala, District Kapurthala, vide order dated 08.05.2018, in CWP-23010-2017, was supplied to the Collector Agrarian, Kapurthala, District Kapurthala, after reconstruction of the record, on account of original record not being traceable.

2. Respondent No. 1 further states that he relinquished charge as Collector Agrarian, Hoshiarpur on 17.07.2018 and in the circumstances, it is the new incumbent on the post of Collector Agrarian, Kapurthala, who has to decide the remand proceedings.

3. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner makes an oral request for impleading Smt. Deepti Uppal, Collector Agrarian, Kapurthala,

the petitioner is accepted and Smt. Deepti Uppal, Collector Agrarian, Kapurthala, District Kapurthala, is impleaded as respondent No. 2. Necessary changes be made in the memo of parties.

4. Learned AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of newly impleaded respondent No. 2 and on telephonic instructions from respondent No.2, states that in view of the record having been received by respondent No.2, remand proceedings shall be decided within three months. The same satisfies learned counsel for the petitioner, who states that in the circumstances, he does not press the instant petition and the same may be disposed of as such while directing respondent No.2 to adhere to the assurance held out by her through the learned AAG, Punjab.

5. In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the parties, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents while directing respondent No. 2 to adhere to the assurance held out by her through the learned AAG, Punjab and to decide the remand proceedings within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
