This petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondent No.4.

Status report dated 10.03.2021 filed on behalf of the respondent-State is already on record.

At this stage, Ms. Mandeep Kaur, Advocate appears and files vakalatnama on behalf of respondent No. 4 in the Court, which is taken on record.

Petitioner No. 2, who is present in the Court and has been identified by learned counsel for respondent No. 4, wishes to withdraw the present petition.

Learned State counsel points out that in their statements, recorded on 14.01.2021 before Surinder Kumar I/C, PP Ghubaya, PS Sadar

Jalalabad, petitioners No. 1 and 2, have specifically stated that now they have no threat to their life and liberty from anyone, if there would be any need, they will inform the Police accordingly.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and petitioner No.2.

In view of the statements of petitioner Nos. 1 and 2 recorded on 14.01.2021 attached with the status report filed on behalf of the respondent-State, no further order is called for in the petition.

The petition is disposed of.
