Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case FIR No.62 dated 13.12.2020, registered under Sections 498-A, 406 IPC (Section 201 IPC was added vide order dated 19.4.2022) at Police Station Women Cell, Ludhiana, District Police Commissionerate Ludhiana.

After interaction with both the counsel for the parties, it is inferred that in pursuance to the order dated 11.1.2021 and 19.4.2022, the petitioner has joined the investigation. Both the parties appeared before the Mediation Centre and settled the dispute amicably. It is also brought to the notice of the Court that petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 has been filed.

Learned counsel for the complainant has also affirmed the aforesaid fact.

Learned State counsel has endorsed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and submitted that he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the orders dated 11.1.2021 and 19.4.2022 are made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
