On 14.01.2020, notice of motion was issued and it was directed that the petitioner shall file an affidavit detailing therein all the moveable and immovable properties owned by him and his parents, his avocation and income from all sources along with a photocopy of his income tax returns of the last three years in case he is an Income Tax payee before the next date of hearing. He was also directed to pay an amount of Rs. 15,000/- as litigation expenses to the respondent on her appearance in the Court.

The case was taken up on 08.03.2022 and an adjournment was sought on behalf of the petitioner on the score that the arguing counsel is not well. The matter was adjourned for today and it was also directed that the amount of litigation expenses be also paid on the date fixed.

Today, neither the affidavit as sought on the previous date of hearing has been placed on record nor has the amount of Rs. 15,000/- as litigation expenses been paid to the respondent.

In such circumstances, the present petition is dismissed for non compliance of the orders.
