[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 01.10.2019 in CWP No.11226 of 2014 in case titled as Sunil Kumar and another vs. State of Punjab and others.

[2] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners states that order, Annexure P/1 dated 01.10.2019 in CWP No.11226 of 2014 has been stayed by Hon'ble the Division Bench vide order dated 26.11.2019 in LPA No.1905 of 2019, therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioners do not press the instant petition at this stage and may be granted liberty to move an application for revival of the contempt petition in the eventuality of the said LPA being dismissed or order of stay being modified.

[3] The same is not opposed to by the learned counsel for the respondents.

[4] Accordingly, in the light of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the contempt petition is

disposed of at this stage as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioners to move an application for revival of the contempt petition in the eventuality of dismissal of LPA No.1905 of 2019 or vacation of stay in the same, whichever is earlier.

[5] All pending misc. applications also stand disposed of.
