NIDHI GUPTA, J. (Oral)

By this petition, the petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No.226, dated 05.08.2020, registered at Police Station Nissing, District Karnal, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 24 of the Immigration Act and Sections 406 and 420 of the IPC (with Section 370 and 384 thereof added later), as also all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of a compromise (copy Annexure P-2), arrived at between the petitioner and respondents no.2.

Pursuant to the order dated 11.01.2021, the report of the learned JMIC, Karnal, dated 21.01.2021, has been received, stating therein that the petitioner/accused Ranjit Singh and the complainant Malkhan Singh appeared before that Court and submitted their written statements to the effect that the matter has been compromised between them with the intervention of the family panchayat.

The compromise is stated to be genuine and effected without any fear, threat, pressure and coercion.

As per the report there is no other person involved in the occurrence except the petitioner and the complainant and no one in this case has been declared as proclaimed offender.

Learned counsel for respondent no.2 does not deny the factum of compromise reached between the parties.

That being so, looking at the nature of the offences alleged to have been committed by the petitioner and the fact that the matter has been compromised between the petitioner and the complainant, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.226, dated 05.08.2020, registered at Police Station Nissing, District Karnal, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 24 of the Immigration Act and Sections 406 and 420 of the IPC (with Section 370 and 384 thereof added later), along with all proceedings emanating therefrom, is hereby quashed.
