The matter has been taken up through Video conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioner has come up in this civil writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* for directing respondents 2 and 3 to grant the monthly pension to the petitioner on account of death of her husband, for which, legal notice dated 27.05.2019 (Annexure P/2) and reminder to legal notice (Anexure P-1) has also been served respondent authorities.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, the directions are issued to the respondent-authorities to duly

consider legal notice dated 27.05.2019 (Annexure P-2) and reminder dated 21.12.2021 (Annexure P-1) of the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

If the petitioner is held entitled for so claimed relief and there is no impediment for granting the same, the relief be released to her without any delay.
