1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order Annexure P/4 dated 12.10.2020, in CWP-16788-2020.
2. Learned counsel for respondent No.3 states that in compliance of order dated 12.10.2020 in CWP-16788-2020, the petitioner has been allowed to continue to work on the post of Section Officer in the office of the Estate Officer-1, HSVP Gurugram and as per reply, salary has also been released to him on the said post. The same satisfies learned counsel for the petitioner, who states that in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the contempt petition and the same may be disposed of accordingly.
3. I have considered the submissions of learned counsel and in view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against respondent No. 3 under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
