The petitioner is aggrieved because an application filed by the private respondents for restoration of a demolished water-course has been allowed. Appeal has also been dismissed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the alleged demolished water-course was actually in dis-use. However, to support his argument, he has not produced any evidence. He only relies upon his oral statement made before the Divisional Canal Officer.

The oral statement is not evidence of the abandonment of the water-course. Thus, the writ petition has no merit and is dismissed.
