Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.100 dated 08.10.2021, under Sections 376, 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Section 120-B IPC added later on vide Rapat No.25 dated 16.10.2021), registered at Police Station Mamdot, District Ferozepur.

Vide order dated 18.01.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 18.01.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Ram Parkash, affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, interim order dated 18.01.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
