The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of order dated 19.10.2021 (Annexure P-8) passed by learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Moga vide which the petitioner has been declared as Proclaimed Person.

The main crux of the arguments advanced by learned counsel for the petitioner would be that the impugned order dated 19.10.2021 (Annexure P-8) was passed without following due process of law. Even further submitted that from the reports attached with the petition, it would be revealed that the petitioner was not residing at the given address and the proclamation was a nullity.
