Petition was filed in the year 2004, under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 praying for punishing the respondents/contemners for disobeying the orders dated 15.01.2004 (Annexure P-2) passed by this Court.

Petition was ordered to be heard along with CWP-365-1998, which was admitted on 03.07.2002.

When called out for hearing, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner. It seems that by sheer effluxion of time and pendency of the contempt petition for around 18 years before this Court, either it has been rendered infructuous or even otherwise the petitioner seems to have lost interest in pursuing the same.

Be that as it may, the contempt petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file an appropriate application in case, any cause of action still survives.
