The petitioner has filed the instant petition for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to investigate and take necessary action against respondent No.4 in FIR No.300 dated 10.12.2021 and Sections 365 and 328 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Nabha, District Patiala.

Learned State counsel at the outset, on instructions from ASI Rajinder Singh, has submitted that the daughter of the petitioner had since been located after she returned to her parents on 30.12.2021. She further submitted that in her statement recorded under Section 164 Cr.P.C., the daughter of the petitioner stated that she had left her house of her own accord as her parents were pressurizing her to get marry against her wishes.

In the wake of the instructions received by learned State counsel and her submissions made before this Court, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the instant petition.
