Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.137 dated 15.10.2016, registered at Police Station Dugri, Ludhiana, under Sections 177, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC.

Fresh status report dated 19.04.2022, by way of affidavit of the Assistant Commissioner of Police (South), Ludhiana, has been filed in the Court today. The same is taken on record.

Vide order dated 03.02.2022 passed by a Coordinate Bench, the petitioner had been granted *ad interim* pre-arrest bail and directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the order dated 03.02.2022 passed by the Coordinate Bench, the petitioner has joined investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Manjit Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and is now not

required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 03.02.2022 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
