The hearing of the case is being held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

The petitioner prays for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus to direct the respondents to reinstate him in service.

The petitioner claims that his services as Home Guard were dispensed with by the Additional Director General of Police, on 05.06.2018. The petitioner has failed to disclose the terms of his appointment. He has also failed to disclose the security of service, if any, available to such Home Guards. Even the order dispensing with his services has not been placed on the file.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, it is evident that the writ petition is bereft of necessary particulars.

Hence, disposed of with liberty to file fresh one with better particulars.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
