The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for the grant of regular bail to the petitioner in respect of FIR No.0022 dated 12.02.2019 registered under Section 302 the IPC at Police Station Sadar Fazilka, District Fazilka.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though, while deciding the first petition filed by the petitioner for the grant of regular bail, this Court had directed the trial Court to examine the material witnesses expeditiously but, despite the expiry of more than one and a half year, material witnesses have not been examined by the trial Court, which fact alone forced the petitioner to file the present petition seeking grant of regular bail.

Learned State counsel submits that he has instructions that next date of hearing before the trial Court is 23.02.2022, on which date, both the

material witnesses namely, complainant Om Parkash and Vijay Kumar will be examined without any fail.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the said statement of the learned State counsel, the petitioner does not press the present petition any further and the same may kindly be disposed of as such.
