Petitioners have approached this Court under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure to seek anticipatory bail in a case FIR No.220 dated 01.11.2021 registered under Section 15 NDPS Act, 1985 at Police Station Dharamkot, District Moga, who apprehend their arrest at the hands of Police.

On 10.01.2022, this Court had passed the following order:

“Learned counsel relies upon the order dated 02.12.2021 (Annexure P-2) passed by this Court in CRM-M-50383-2021 and contends that similarly situated co-accused has already been released on interim pre arrest bail vide order dated 02.12.2021.

Notice of motion for 22.03.2022.

Meanwhile, the petitioners shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be admitted to interim bail on their furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioners shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

To be heard along with CRM-M-50383-2021 ”

compliance of the above order, the petitioners associated themselves in the investigation and cooperated during interrogation.

Learned State counsel, who is instructed by ASI Jasvir Singh states that indeed the petitioners have joined the investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 10.01.2022 is made absolute.
