[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 27.10.2010 in CWP-17332-2009.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1) dated 27.10.2010 reveals that CWP No.17332 of 2009 was allowed in terms of order passed in CWP No.16817 of 2007 with direction to disburse the necessary relief to the petitioner within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that relief as per entitlement in terms of decision Annexure P-1 has been released to the petitioner, therefore, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not

calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
