The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail in Criminal Complaint No.COMI-29/2019 dated 24.01.2019, filed under Sections 406, 420, 506 and 120-B of IPC pending before the Court of learned JMIC, Jalandhar.

A perusal of the file would reveal that vide order dated 13.12.2021 (Annexure P-5) passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge-II, Jalandhar, the petitioner was granted concession of interim bail with the direction to appear before the trial Court and be admitted on bail on any condition the Court was likely to impose.

In pursuant to the said direction, the petitioner did not appear before the trial Court on account of getting corona positive and the anticipatory bail application was dismissed vide order dated 21.12.2021 (Annexure P-6).

Ms. Rishima Verma, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of the respondent.

Faced with the aforesaid situation, the present petition is disposed of with direction to the petitioner to appear before learned trial Court on or before 25.01.2022 and file fresh application for regular bail, which will be decided by trial Court in accordance with law.

Till then, interim bail is granted to the petitioner.
