This case has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Pleadings on record would indicate that the petitioner had participated in an e-auction exercise conducted by respondent-HSVP and had submitted a bid online for Booth No.97-P, Sector-13, Urban Estate, Panipat. Apparently the bid submitted having been found insufficient/below the reserve price, an option was given to the petitioner to up his bid.

It is not in dispute that a counter offer was thereafter submitted by the petitioner for the booth in question.

On the previous date of hearing, Mr. P.S. Chauhan, Advocate, learned counsel representing the respondent-HSVP had informed us that the counter offer submitted by the petitioner had been considered by the duly constituted Committee but the same has not been accepted. Accordingly, matter was adjourned for counsel for respondent-HSVP to place on record the rejection order.

During the course of hearing today, Mr. P.S. Chauhan, Advocate, has informed us that the matter has been re-examined and pursuant to which a decision has been taken to accept the counter offer made by the petitioner.

Mr. Sandeep Sharma, Advocate, counsel representing the petitioner concedes to such factual premise. He further submits that the petitioner is ready and willing to deposit the requisite amount so as to avail of such counter offer for the booth in question.

In the light of such subsequent developments, nothing would remain to be decided in the instant writ petition.

Writ petition is disposed of as infructuous.
