GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner has approached this Court seeking grant of anticipatory bail in respect of a case registered against him vide FIR No.0140 dated 30.08.2021 at Police Station Dugri, District Ludhiana, under Sections 148/149/323/427/452/506 IPC.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the FIR in question came to be lodged due to some misunderstanding, which has now been resolved and that the complainant does not have any objection for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
3. Learned State counsel has, however, feigned ignorance about the compromise, but has informed that pursuant to interim directions issued by this Court, the petitioner has since joined investigation and is not required for any custodial interrogation.

4. Vide order dated 24.05.2022, this Court had ordered for issuance of notice to respondent No.2, but despite having been served, he has not put in appearance.
5. Having regard to the aforestated position wherein the petitioner is stated to have joined investigation and is not required for any custodial interrogation, the petition is accepted and the interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 11.01.2022 are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
