The petitioner has filed the present petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to the respondents to consider the objection (Annexure P-2) filed by the petitioner against the draft notification dated 11.11.2021 (Annexure P-1) before passing the final order under Rule 8(2) of the Haryana Municipal Delimitation of Wards Rules, 1977.

Learned State counsel has produced the official record of Wardbandi, Municipal Council, Narnaul. As per the record, 8 objections, including the petitioner, were received against delimitation of wards and notice for appearance was issued to the petitioner. He appeared before Municipal Council, Narnaul on 23.11.2021 and

signature of the petitioner is there on the attendance sheet. The petitioner was given an opportunity of hearing. As per the report, the petitioner had also gone on the site for inspection. It has been further observed that earlier there were 25 wards and now there are 31 wards. The objections were rejected on 30.11.2021 and the order was sent through dispatch register on 02.12.2021. On 07.12.2021 final notification was issued. The petitioner cannot raise any further objection as his objection has already been heard and decided.

Keeping in view the above-said fact that the petitioner had already appeared before Municipal Council, Narnaul and his objection was decided, he seeks to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
