[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1, dated 04.10.2008 in CWP No.4886 of 2003 in case titled as Court on its own motion vs. State of Punjab and another.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 dated 04.10.2008 reveals that CWP No.4886 of 2003 was decided while granting liberty to a public spirited person to apprise the authorities of any encroachment and in case of the same not being removed, liberty was granted to institute contempt proceedings.

[3] Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that despite representations, Annexures P/2 and P/5 having been served on the respondents apprising them of the unauthorized encroachments in the Galiara Project around Sri Harmandir Sahib and requiring them to ensure removal thereof, no steps were taken to do the needful, therefore, the

instant petition was filed but now the encroachments had been removed, therefore, the petitioner does not wish to press the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the contempt petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.

[5] Rule discharged.

[6] All pending misc. applications also stand disposed of.
