[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/2 dated 22.12.2005.

[2] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners states that order, Annexure P/1 dated 23.09.2005 in CWP No.7446 of 2003 on the basis of which directions were issued in Annexure P/2 dated 22.12.2005 in CWP No.20009 of 2005 has been set aside by Hon'ble the Supreme Court in Civil Appeal No.(S)-9008-9009 of 2012 in case titled as State of Haryana and Others vs. Ishwar Singh, therefore, the instant petition has become infructuous and may be disposed of as such.

[3] In view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the contempt petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
