AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

Due to COVID-19 situation, the Court is convened through video conference.

This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is filed for grant of interim regular bail for two months in FIR No. 71 dated 30.5.2021, under Sections 21, 22 and 29 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Dhanaula, District Barnala on the ground that expected due date of delivery of the wife of the petitioner is 3.2.2022.

On the last date, learned counsel for the State sought time to verify the facts.

Today, on instructions, learned counsel for the State submits that the expected date of delivery is 15.2.2022.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, considering the medical condition of the wife of the petitioner and the fact that there is no other male member in the family to take care, the petitioner is granted three weeks interim bail from 8.2.2022, subject to furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate. He shall surrender before the jail authorities after completion of three

weeks interim bail.

The petition is disposed of.
