The hearing of the case is being held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

The petitioner prays for regular bail pending trial in a criminal case arising from FIR No.281, dated 04.12.2021, registered under Section 363-A, 370, 120-B IPC, at Police Station City South, Moga.

As per the case of the prosecution, Sh. Vishal Kumar abducted 8 months old son of the first informant Karamjit Singh from the hospital, and thereafter, handed over the child to the petitioner who is issueless.

The learned counsel representing the petitioner contends that the child was recovered from the custody of Rachpal Singh and the petitioner has been falsely implicated. He further contends that the petitioner is in service of Talwandi Sabo Power Ltd.

On conclusion of the investigation, the challan has already been presented and the petitioner has already suffered incarceration for a period of 1 month and 12 days. The conclusion of the trial is likely to take a long time.

Hence, the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to

furnishing of adequate surety to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Accordingly, the petition is allowed with the aforesaid directions.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
