The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.93 dated 7.10.2019 registered under Sections 406, 498-A IPC at Police Station Women Cell, Jalandhar.

By virtue of the order dated 25.2.2022, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated. He submits that the parties were referred to the Mediation Centre, however, the same remained unsuccessful.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rajesh Kumar, has endorsed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the order dated 25.2.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
