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HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

This petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India seeking direction to respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of petitioner at the hands of private respondents No. 4 to 7.

It is stated that petitioner is married to respondent No. 7. However, for the harassment and maltreatment at the hands of respondent No. 7, petitioner has started living separately from respondent No. 7 for the last 2 years. She is presently residing at Village Alampur, District Moga and is running a boutique. The couple has 2 children from the marriage both of whom are presently residing with respondent No. 7.

It is the case of petitioner that respondent No. 7 is repeatedly threatening the petitioner and demanding money. He is not permitting her to live in peace and earn her livelihood. The petitioner has already filed a petition for divorce which is pending. The petitioner has repeatedly reported the official respondents. However, no action has been taken on her representation. Copy of such representation is Annexure P-2.

Without in anyway opining on the veracity of the allegations of the petitioner, this petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga (respondent No. 2) to look into the representation (Annexure P-2) and take such action as may be warranted in law.
