As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellants, learned counsel and representative of the respondent – Insurance Company (separately recorded), a sum of Rs.7,50,000/- (Rupees Seven lakh and fifty thousand only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellants in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. Disbursal of the amount pertaining to appellants shall be in terms of award rendered by the Tribunal.

Accordingly, we **dispose of** this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque/demand draft for Rs.7,50,000/- in terms of award rendered by the Tribunal with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within a period of four weeks, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the crossed-cheque/demand draft to learned counsel/representative of the respondent – Insurance Company. The appellant(s)' counsel/appellant(s) may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
