Prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to the official respondents not to harass and humiliate the petitioners by calling them in the police station again and again at the instance of respondents No. 7 to 9 without complying the provisions of Section 160 of Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners No. 2 and 3 are parents-in-law and petitioner No. 1 is brother-in-law, of respondent No. 9. There is a matrimonial dispute between respondent No. 9 and Yadwinder Singh, son and brother of the petitioners.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of this Court, learned State counsel accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that both the parties have moved complaints, upon which an SIT has been constituted and the matter is pending before Superintendent of Police (Headquarters), Kapurthala.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

Since SIT has already been constituted regarding the grievances raised by the parties, no order are called for in the present petition.
